

ONE DAY AT A TIME AT THE STATE FAIR



WHO: Area 47's Public Information Committee in cooperation with Syracuse Intergroup and District 340 Public Information Committee has submitted the application for an exhibit at the New York State Fair again this year.

WHAT: Alcoholics Anonymous Public Information Exhibit at the New York State Fair



WHEN: August 20 – September 1, 2025 • 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.

WHERE: Science & Industry Building

WHY: 868,745 visitors attended the New York State Fair in 2024. An A.A. P.I. exhibit located in the Science and Technology Building alongside health and wellness exhibitors has the potential to reach hundreds if not thousands of visitors each day. It's a big opportunity to share information about the availability of A.A. in communities across the state.



HOW: With support from all four Areas in New York State—financial and most importantly staffing—the exhibit must be staffed for 12 hours a day—all 13 days of the fair.

Because the fair lasts for 13 days. We need **13 dedicated volunteers** to serve as **Group Leads** for their committee or home group's participation for **one full day**.

Group Leads will be required to:

1. Attend a New York State Fair Public Information orientation workshop, time and location to be determined. Virtual will be available for out-of-town participants.
2. Make sure that your group members are **fully trained in all areas covered in the orientation**. This means working with them in person or asking them to attend the orientation session with you
3. Ensure the exhibit is staffed by two people at all times, one of which must have at least one year of continuous sobriety.
