### D.C.M. Report

- At the August 12 Area Assembly, 1) the DCMs were asked to check with their groups to see if the ability to make online contributions to Area 47 would be beneficial as compared to simply sending a check or money order the Area 47 treasurer. Please let me know. 2) There was discussion of adding the "Meeting Guide" app to the Area 47 website. There is some concern as to how to maintain and update it. The use of the "App" is also being discussed at A.A. World Services (AAWS). 3) Nikki P., Treatment Chair, reported on the Treatment Committee's review of the pamphlets, Speaking at Non-AA Meetings and If You Are a Professional. The assembly voted to submit an agenda item to the General Service Conference requesting edits to the pamphlet If You Are a Professional. 4) A motion was made by our Area 47 treasurer to establish a prudent reserve of \$4500 and to eliminate the current ceiling of six months worth of operating expenses—further, that all funds exceeding the prudent reserve be contributed to the General Service Office. The motion was tabled and will come up again in Old Business at the October assembly, as the September Assembly will be devoted to electing a new delegate and panel of officers. 5) A motion was made to purchase a printer (approximate cost: \$200) for the Area secretary to bring to assemblies. The motion passed. 6) There was also discussion of how to handle updates to the Area 47 handbook and how to handle prolonged absences of Area officers and/or committee chairs.
- The District 340 "Qualifications and Responsibilities" document that was approved last month has been edited as requested and will be available by email or at our August meeting.
