Committee Reports

Public Information: The District 340 Public Information (P.I.) Committee has been working to provide Farnham and COCOAA (both out-patient treatment facilities in Oswego county) with informational pamphlet packets for their waiting rooms and—once those packets have been distributed—will be providing P.I./C.P.C. (Cooperation with the Professional Community) informational packets to the counseling staffs at both facilities.

Treatment: District 340's Treatment Committee Chair, Michele O., reports that COCOAA (County of Oswego Council on Alcoholism & Addictions) has been set up with established "constants," Lauren G. for Oswego and Dan O., Fulton. The "constants" will ensure that an AA speaker is available on the last Thursday of each month starting in September. Alicia K., treatment committee member, will serve as "constant" for Farnham in Fulton. The committee is also working with Harbor Lights Chemical Dependency Service to establish a speaker schedule for them.

Area Assembly: Renee and I will inventory the supply bins this Saturday and shop for supplies accordingly. We will be serving a light lunch, plus coffee and snacks throughout the day.
